Scott Elliott established a \$250,000 endowment shared equally among the Departments of Economics, Philosophy, and Sociology-Anthropology to advance the mission and vision of each Department. Mr. Elliott specifically wanted to recognize three faculty in this award: Dr. Matthew Morey (Economics), Dr. Paul Baker (Philosophy), and Dr. Richard Stivers (Sociology-Anthropology). Mr. Elliott received his bachelor's degree in Economics in 1985. The Scott Elliott Undergraduate Scholarship was established to provide support to a student in economics who has exhibited academic excellence.

Value of Award: \$500

Eligibility: Economics majors with between 75 and 90 hours of academic credit at the time of application. Preference will be given to applicants that have established an outstanding academic record. Though a student may apply for the F. Russell Glasener-Economics Advisory Board Scholarship, the Scott M. Elliott Scholarship, and the Dr. John Chizmar-Dr. Anthony Ostrosky Scholarship, a student cannot be selected for the other two scholarships in the same academic year.
